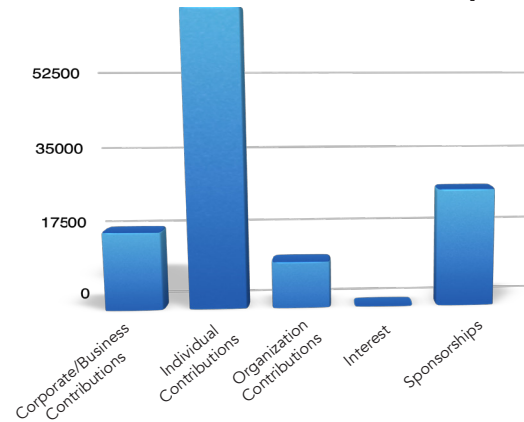

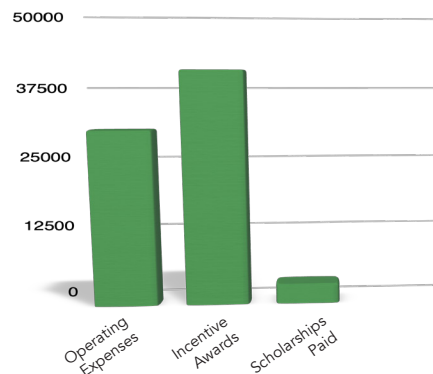

PROGRAM

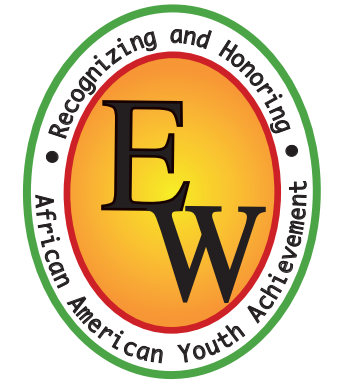
