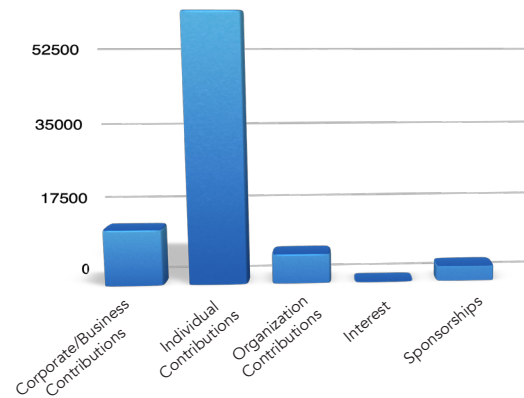

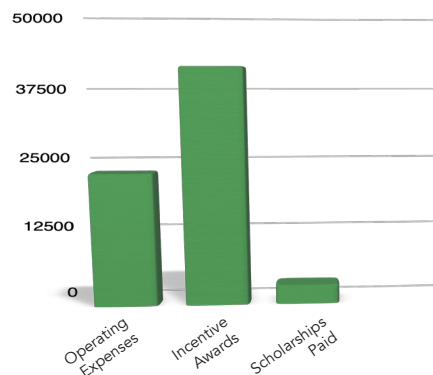

PROGRAM

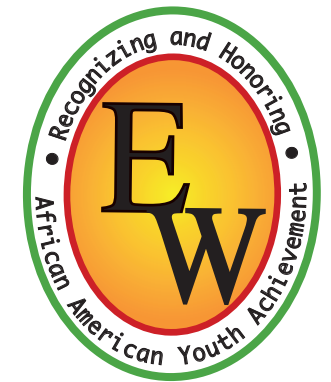
